




WELCOME TO L'OM, A NEW CONCERT HALL BASED IN LIÈGE!


Scheduled to open in **autumn of 2023**, OM is located in a historically rich industrial zone, near the center of the cities of Liege and Seraing. The venue is easily accessible from major roads and highways leading to Germany, Luxembourg, and Holland, and only an hour away from Brussels.

Featuring 3 different halls with varying sizes and capacities, OM has a lot to offer. The main hall, the Trasenster Hall, can host up to 1,700 people, while the other two have capacities of 500 and 300 people respectively.

The building itself was originally designed by Belgian architect Georges Dedoyard in 1948, and has been recently renovated by the City of Seraing to maintain its original design and convenience. After hosting numerous social and cultural functions in the mid-20th century, the building and its neighborhood are now undergoing an unprecedented revival.

The team behind the internationally acclaimed **Les Ardentes** festival, **Jazz in Liège** festival, and **Reflektor** club, will be running the venue.

The OM Hall is easily accessible, close to the main roads and the city centers of Liege and Seraing. More than 900 parking spaces are available in the area

TERRITORIAL ENVIRONMENT

The district of Liege is a crossroads territory, at the junction of major European axes, with a TGV station, the 3rd largest inland port in Europe, the 8th largest freight airport in Europe, a trilogy of ports and soon a TGV Freight terminal.

About 3.2 million people live within a 2-hour drive in cities such as Maastricht (30km), Aachen (50km), Namur (60km), Brussels (100Km), Cologne (120km), Antwerp (120km), Luxembourg (165km).


There are 100,000 million people living within a radius of 400 km of Liege, spread over 6 countries and speaking 4 languages.


- Many modulation options, based on the desires and needs of each one;

- Over **900 parking** spaces around the building;




SALLE TRASENSTER · 1.500 PAX






SALLE LOUVA · 500 PAX

SALLE CLUB · 300 PAX




